6. AM Same as A but Involved in Combat Mission
7. AS Accident in Friendly Territory Resulting in Salvage of the Aircraft – Not Combat Mission Related
8. ASM Same as AS but Involved in Combat Mission
9. WWS Salvage of Aircraft as War Weary
10. RAAF Transfer of Aircraft to Royal Australian Air Force
11. OG Transfer of Aircraft to Other Groups
12. PI Transfer to Philippines Islands for Continuation of War Service There
13. NT Whether Nose Turret Installed (Applies Only to Initial Deployment Aircraft) During 1943 and While in 380<sup>th</sup> Service
14. RUS Returned to U.S. at End of War
