

GLORIA MARIE NEW ORLEANS is one moniker that appears nowhere in a surviving record of nicknames assigned to 90th BG bombers. By 1944, the 'Jolly Rogers," who had begun as the only Liberator group in the South Pacific, were beginning to get plenty of company. As for the olive-drab paint scheme that had become so familiar, it had begun to give way to what is commonly, if somewhat misleadingly, called natural metal finish at around the same time. (Robert F.
